2-D Art and Design Selected Works, *Score 2*

Scoring Criteria

2-D/3-D/Drawing Art and Design Skills

Visual evidence of **rudimentary** 2-D/3-D/Drawing **skills**.

Materials, Processes, and Ideas

Little to no evidence of **visual relationships** among materials, processes, or ideas.

Writing

Written evidence **may identify** materials, processes, and ideas.

Rationale for Score

The visual evidence demonstrates rudimentary 2-D skills. Work 1 uses repetition of color with pink and blue cast in different amounts, while various sized gray rectangular shapes echo through the page. The variation in size of the blue areas and the diagonal placement of the compositional elements create some sense of movement. Although there is an effective use of value in the clouds within work 2, line and shape as a whole are awkward. In work 3, gray columns created by the hatched words interact with the black vertical stripes to create a sense of rhythm. The large rose is not integrated into the composition.

There is little to no evidence of visual relationships among materials, processes, or ideas. Some concern for material with the deliberate integration of newspaper is evident but does not visually relate to the subject matter or the ideas present. Ideas are not developed enough to suggest relationships within the work or with the viewer.

The written evidence identifies materials, processes, and ideas.

Height: 7 inches

Material(s): Acrylic on canvas

Process(es): I painted and added newspaper then put mod podge over it.
