Materials, Processes, and Ideas

Visual relationships among materials, processes, and ideas are evident but may be unclear or inconsistently demonstrated. Score Rationale

The written evidence identifies materials, processes, and ideas.

This portfolio shows evidence of moderate design skills. Throughout the portfolio, there is a juxtaposition of various textures, shapes, and colors. In work 2, the vibrant colors in the composition's center contrast against the negative space's neutral colors to create emphasis, "comparing bland life and childhood imagination." Work 4 also uses similar design choices but with less success. Linear perspective creates a sense of depth in an interior space, but the juxtaposition of elements appears flat. Although, in work 5, complementary colored hands divide the composition in half to create balance, the intentional design choices demonstrate moderate 2-D skills.

Throughout the portfolio, the idea of childhood and growing up is evident. Work 1 describes a growing flower. However, the idea does not guide the thread's application or appear to have a purpose. In the written evidence in work 3, the connection between idea, materials, and processes, "composed eerie feeling with road leading back/moon lighting," is evident but is inconsistently demonstrated. The road doesn't lead back to the moon, and the materials do not adequately connect to the idea. Though some works have somewhat successful connections between materials, processes, and ideas, they are inconsistently demonstrated.
