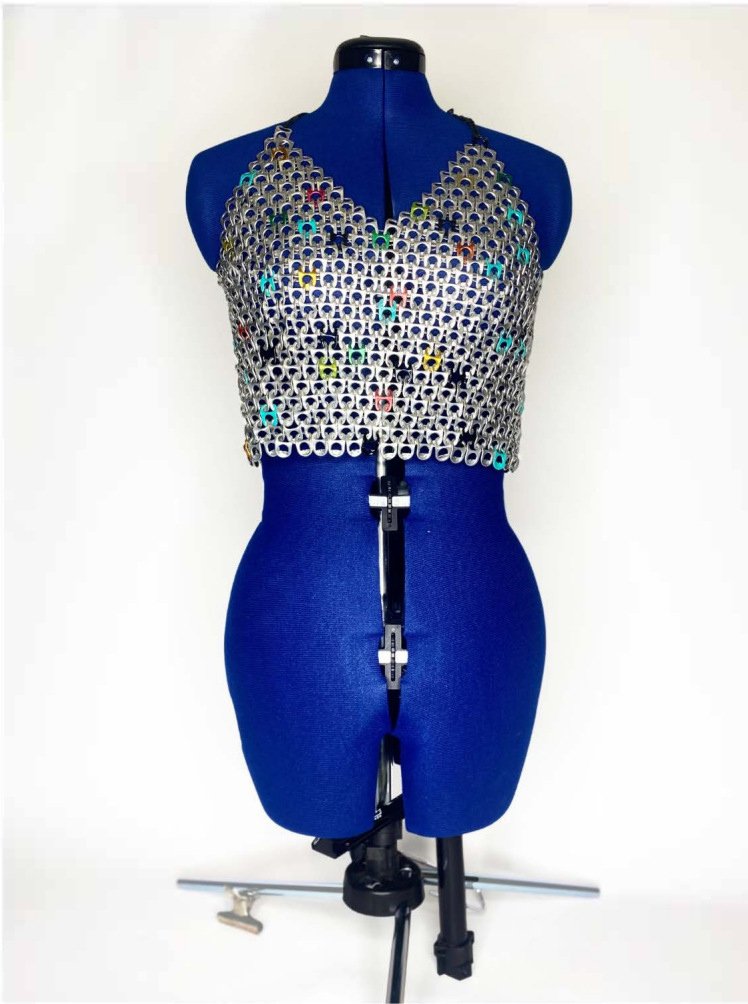

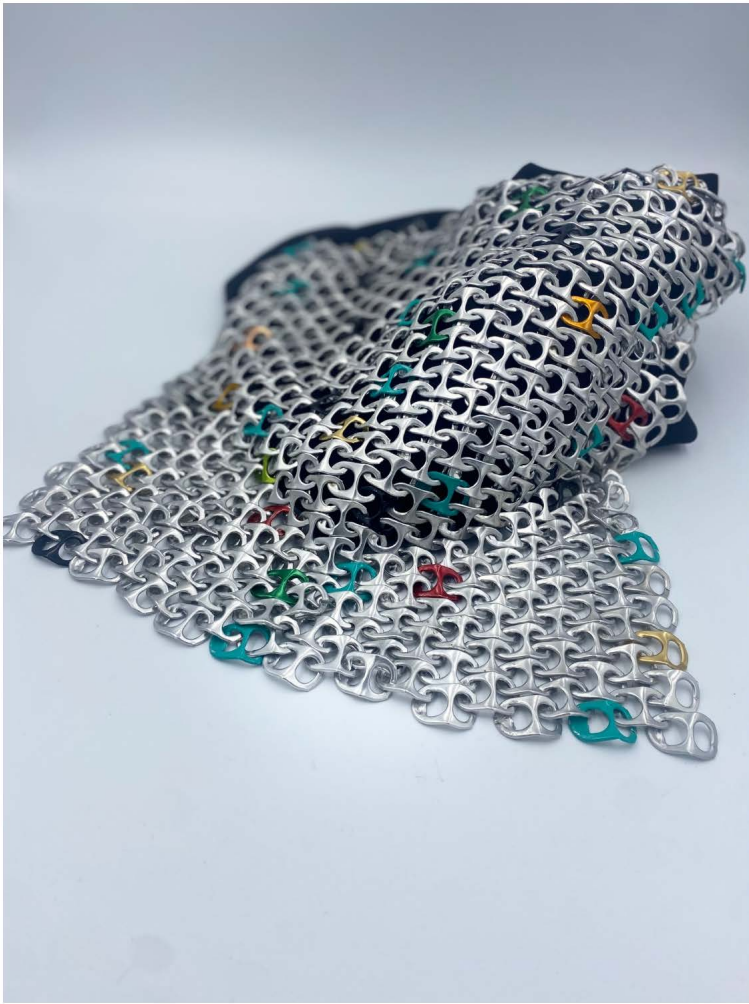

Writing

Written evidence **may identify** materials, processes, and ideas.

3-D Art and Design Skills

Visual evidence of **rudimentary** 3-D skills.

Materials, Processes, and Ideas

Little to no evidence of **visual relationships** among materials, processes, or ideas.

Score Rationale

The written evidence identifies materials, processes, and ideas but fails to provide a depth of intention and purpose.

The visual evidence in these works demonstrates the rudimentary to moderate application of 3-D skills. The singular construction method utilized throughout the portfolio limits significant engagement with 3-D skills, and the repetitious material manipulation promotes a lack of variety. Developing the construction techniques would enhance the likelihood of incorporating focal point/emphasis, occupied/unoccupied space, contrast, and the integration of juxtapositional components and potentially result in a higher score point.

The work shows little evidence of visual relationships among materials, processes, or ideas. The weaving of aluminum can tabs does not adequately relate to “femininity within the context of Catholicism.” The weaving of a single material creates visual repetition and movement, but the physical and conceptual processes are underdeveloped. The visual idea is not communicated effectively through the utilization of materials and processes.
