





Score Rationale

This portfolio earns a score of 1 because it presents visual evidence of both rudimentary and moderate 2-D skills, with limited control over compositional structure, figure-ground relationships, and spatial balance. In Image 12, for example, a smiling face formed from salad elements is difficult to perceive due to minimal contrast and uneven distribution of visual weight. The smile gets visually lost within the cluttered texture of the leaves, and the off-center composition draws the viewer's eye toward the upper right corner rather than the intended focal point. These issues weaken emphasis and proportion within the design.

Image 6 demonstrates slightly more control, suggesting moderate 2-D skills. The repetitive arrangement of oranges and bell peppers shows awareness of rhythm and unity. However, the spacing along the bottom edge is inconsistent, and the misalignment of the lower right pepper disrupts the intended pattern. The composition could benefit from cropping or a more deliberate activation of negative space to support clarity and balance.

Summary: This portfolio earns a score of 1 because the visual evidence shows basic design considerations but lacks consistent control of 2-D skills. Compositional alignment, figure-ground relationships, and emphasis are inconsistently applied across the work.
