Response:

My sustained investigation focuses on the inquiry: how do I change in appearance, knowledge, thought, personality and those I surround myself with as my life continues to progress? This topic is relevant because I'm quite literally always growing and getting older, which also means that I'm changing as well. I used traditional materials such as watercolors, pens, and color pencils for my analog pieces. I also incorporated digital art by using procreate. The elements I illustrated in my pieces were mark making and texture to express the subjects and how details were always changing.

Response:

In images 1,3,10,11 I explore this question by making works that portray my growth and the people who have shaped me. These works led me to the idea that I'm ever changing, which I further investigate by portraying the relationship between me and my past self by creating a subject to represent me as a child in images 4,6,8,15. By practicing line work in 10,11 I improved my works legibility. In works 4,12 I experimented with lighting so that my work invokes the feeling I intend. I wanted to improve the detail, so I revised the final touches in 4,8,13 to better portray the subject.


Score Rationale

This sustained investigation explores "the relationship between me and my past self," and the written and visual evidence of practice, experimentation, and revision clearly demonstrates how the investigation developed over time, earning a score of 3 for Row B. The repeated use of digital media across many works, specifically in Images 4–9 and 12–15, provides strong visual evidence of consistent practice. Within these digital pieces, experimentation with line weight, line quality, and color shows how technical refinement and visual choices were informed by repeated use of the medium.

Revisions are thoughtfully applied throughout the portfolio, with clear connections to the evolving inquiry. In Image 2, for example, the composition, mark-making, and shading were revised to more clearly distinguish the "old art" from childhood (surrounding the figure) from the "current self" shown at the center. In Image 4, the student revised the stylistic contrast between the two selves, opting for a more realistic rendering of the older self versus a cartoon-like younger self—a decision carried into Image 5. These changes reflect intentional visual strategies that clarify the conceptual goal.

Further evidence of experimentation and development is seen in Image 7, where the line color is adjusted from black to gray to "keep the focus on the faces," showing how subtle changes in technique enhance emphasis. Similarly, the written evidence for Image 6 explains how contrasting backgrounds, day for the younger self and night for the older, were used to reflect identity changes over time. The idea was revised and refined from the earlier sketch in Image 7, showing a clear link between experimentation and conceptual growth.

Summary: The sustained investigation demonstrates consistent practice, meaningful experimentation, and purposeful revision that contribute to the development of the inquiry, justifying a score of 3 for Row B.




