

BigFuture School and Connections for AP Students

An Overview for AP Coordinators



BigFuture® School helps AP students connect skills they may be developing in AP courses with career and college options. **Starting August 3, AP coordinators can enable access to BigFuture School and Connections™ for students 13 and older enrolled in AP courses in their school.**



This free app strengthens the connection between your school's AP program and college and career exploration. AP coordinators can enable access for your school during AP Registration and Ordering set-up. Students will then have the option to use interactive tools on the BigFuture School app to plan what comes next.

Students can also opt in to Connections within BigFuture School. Connections is a program that enables students to discover up to 900 nonprofit colleges, scholarship providers, and government agencies administering educational programs that are actively looking for students like them.

**BigFuture School and Connections are not offered to students as part of their AP course participation in New York or outside of the United States at this time. Students must be 13 and older to access the app. There may be other exclusions.*

BigFuture School and Connections access for AP students:

1. SCHOOL ENABLES ACCESS

AP coordinators can enable their school's access to BigFuture School and Connections in AP Registration and Ordering — either during initial setup or anytime in settings.

2. ELIGIBLE STUDENTS GET ACCESS

After a school enables access, students will see the option with instructions to access the BigFuture School app when joining their AP class section in My AP. Students who skip this step can access the app anytime through their My AP profile.

3. STUDENTS CAN JOIN CONNECTIONS

Once they've downloaded and logged into the BigFuture School app, students can decide to opt into Connections (where available). Students can opt in or out of Connections at any time.
