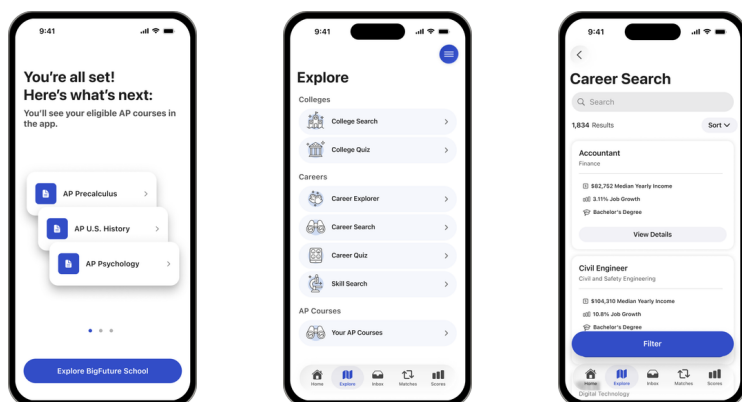


BigFuture School and Connections: Now Available to AP Students



BigFuture® helps AP students discover what comes next, connecting the types of skills developed in their AP courses to career and college options. Starting in August 2026, BigFuture School will be available to students 13 and older enrolled in AP courses whose schools enable access.

This free app empowers students to uncover college and career opportunities and navigate their next steps with confidence.

Students can also opt in to Connections™ within BigFuture School. Connections is a program that enables students to discover up to 900 nonprofit colleges, scholarship providers, and government agencies administering educational programs that may be a good fit and are actively looking for students like them.

**BigFuture School and Connections are not offered to students as part of their AP course participation in New York or outside of the United States at this time. Students must be 13 and older to access the app. There may be other exclusions.*

PERSONALIZE COLLEGE AND CAREER EXPLORATION

Through BigFuture School, students get access to free, personalized college and career planning guidance. Interactive tools, such as College Search, College Quiz, College Matches, Career Search, Career Quiz, and Career Explorer, equip students to connect academic skills they may be developing in their AP courses with potential careers and majors.

SUPPORT EARLIER FUTURE PLANNING

Access to the app supports AP students earlier in high school when they explore options for courses, colleges, and careers.

SECURE FOR STUDENTS AND SCHOOLS

Access is simple, secure, and driven by schools and students.
