Scoring Criteria

Rationale for Score

2-D/3-D/Drawing Art and Design Skills

Visual evidence of **advanced** 2-D/3-D/Drawing **skills**.

The visual evidence demonstrates advanced 2-D skills through diagonal compositions (image 3), color and lighting emphasis (images 1, 2, 3, and 5), hierarchy (images 2, 3, 4, and 5), proportion (images 3 and 5) and transparency layering (images 1-5). Symmetrical and asymmetrical balances show a dynamic and very successful use of 2-D skills.

Materials, Processes, and Ideas

Visual relationships among materials, processes, and ideas are **clearly evident** and **demonstrate synthesis**.

Visual relationships among materials, processes, and ideas are clearly evident and demonstrate synthesis. Quotes from the processes and ideas text further this evidence. In image 2 the student writes, "I used opacity and digitized text to show how religious identity can supersede individual identity." The statement for image 3 includes, "I wanted to synthesize how race plays a role in how I am viewed and how I view myself...I used opacity and personal writing to show I rewrite my own identity as opposed to accepting labels." Finally, image 4 tells the viewer how materials and ideas are synthesized, "I used gradient and opacity to show how political identity is more relative than absolute."

Colors such as red and yellow create emphasis and focus (images 1, 2, 3, and 5). The graphic organization of text in image 5 further informs the idea behind the work. The use of transparency, juxtaposition, contrast, movement, and active compositions shows clear synthesis evidence.




Idea(s): Intrigued by political opinion and how much of it is constituted by
